Improved Instruction Through Technology in the Covid Era

Several panel sessions are scheduled with moderators including David Barr, Bridget Stepan and other MBA members covering “Google Classroom” and “Improved Instruction Through Technology” and other “Tech Talk.” Also, Josh Prewett from the Yamaha Corporation will present “An Overview of Yamaha Software and Apps” and a session on Yamaha’s notation software “DORICO.”

Traditional sessions are scheduled as well. “Music Medics” Matt Wilson will return to present “Instrument Repair Techniques.” Dave Barr will lead “Fun with Yarn & Mallets” as we re-yarn mallets, so remember to bring your old mallets to renew. As many of our participants teach in small districts and are responsible for vocal & general music too, we have asked Dean Peterson to do a session “Help for Band Directors Conducting Choirs” that will include warmups, quality sound production and other helpful tips.
