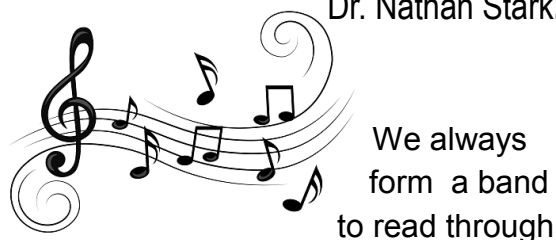


The 19th Annual Montana Bandmasters Association Seeley Lake Rendezvous!

discussed. Another area of discussion will
be "Presenting & Funding Listening
Opportunities for Your Students."
We will continue our "Hands On" sessions
with the remaining brass instruments not

covered last year having everyone playing
Trumpet and Trombone. Several areas of
percussion will be covered as well including
"Beginning Trap Set," "Drum Line" and
"Concert Percussion Techniques." Bring
your batons too as Dr. Tobin Stewart from
MSU will be presenting some "Hands On
Conducting" activities with us.
